

## **Student Dress Code**

### **TOPS (Shirts, Sweatshirts, Zippered Jackets)**

- Long or short sleeve tops are acceptable as long as the top covers the midsection and chest areas and is worn right side out.
- Colors: any, but must be a solid color(s)
- School sanctioned/sponsored spirit, team, athletic wear, either Seymour or Collegiate, are permitted.
- Shirts supporting local community organizations/businesses must say Seymour and be of an appropriate school-content.
- Head coverings and hoods are not permitted to be worn in the building for safety reasons.
- Prohibited tops:
  - Designs and logos
  - Examples of designs would be, but are not limited to: camouflage, floral print, tie-dye, plaid, stripes, screenprints, coloration that makes an image or logo, etc.

### **BOTTOMS (Shorts, Pants, Skirts, Dresses)**

- Bottoms must be a solid color.
- All bottoms must be worn at the waist.
- Skirts, shorts, and dresses must be knee length
- Prohibited bottoms:
  - Blue denim
  - Athletic shorts/pants
  - Logos
  - Slits, cuts or tears above the knee
  - Leggings unless worn under a dress/skirt of appropriate length.
  - Yoga pants

### **SHOES**

- Colors: any
- Style: dress, casual, non-cleated athletic, or boots (flip flops, backless sandals, high heels, or house slippers are prohibited)
- Condition: footwear should be free of “wheels,” holes, and in good repair

### **ACCESSORIES**

- Purses, gym bags, book bags, etc. are not permitted to be in the classroom. These accessories should be placed in the student’s locker upon arrival to school.
- Scarves are permitted as long as they are not covering up a non-compliant top. It is up to the discretion of the teacher to ask students to remove the scarf for safety purposes, or if the scarf is distracting the student from the educational process.
- Headbands and wristbands with logos are not permitted.
- Accessories that cause a disruption to the school environment will be prohibited.
