Kazuo Ishiguro the novelist best known for “The remains of the Day” was awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature. Ishiguro who was born in Japan moved to the United Kingdom when he was just 5 years old. He published “The Remains of the Day” in 1989. Last year’s prize was awarded to Bob Dylan. The Swedish Academy says that the themes Ishiguro wrote were most associated with memories, time, and self-diffusion. Alfred Nobel, the Swedish industrialist and inventor whose will established the prizes, said he wanted the literature award to honor "ideal" work, without defining the term.
