


SMS Owls News

- **ILEARN** Testing: We appreciate your support as we begin preparations for ILEARN testing. Practice testing will take place on Monday and Tuesday April 12th and 13th at 8:45 am. The first official test begins on April 19th at 8:45 am. We will test on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, April 19th-22nd.
 - The Department of Education requires all virtual students to take the practice and operational ILEARN tests at brick/mortar schools. Additional information, plans, and the schedule for full virtual students and families will be shared in a different correspondence.
 - All testing will begin at approximately 8:45 a.m. each day.
 - We would very much appreciate all parents and guardians to have conversations related to the following testing topics. Sharing a consistently supportive message with your student will make a positive impact on his or her effort and performance.
 - Growth is the goal! Try to do better than two years ago.
 - Chromebooks must be charged and bring your corded earbuds/headphones - this is a daily expectation.
 - Help ensure your student gets a good night sleep, eats a healthy breakfast, and drinks plenty of water. Remember that breakfast and lunch are free this year at all students at Seymour Middle School!
 - Be on time and in attendance every day.
 - Place personal cell phones and smart watches in lockers this is also a daily expectation.
 - Encourage your student to have a positive attitude, check all work, give 100% effort, and take his or her time. Remember that the test is not timed.
 - ILEARN scores, including additional data, are used at both SMS and SHS to assist with identifying class eligibility, related arts/elective opportunities and the need for remediation. In addition, the data generates our school wide letter grade. Let's all continue to strive for excellence.
